\*\*Black History Month is an annually observed commemorative month originating in the United States, where it is also known as African-American History Month. It began as a way of remembering important people and events in African American history, before it spread to other countries where it could celebrate black people worldwide. It initially lasted a week before becoming a month-long observation in 1970. It is celebrated for the entire month of February in the US and Canada. The Wall Street Journal describes Black History Month as "a time when the culture and contributions of African Americans take center stage in a variety of cultural institutions including theaters, libraries, and museums." Black History Month received official recognition from the government until 2025. To celebrate Black History Month Maple Avenue will feature music by African American artists and composers each Sunday.
